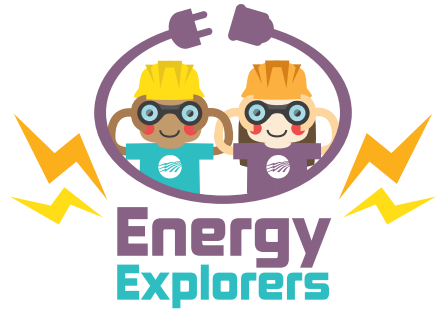
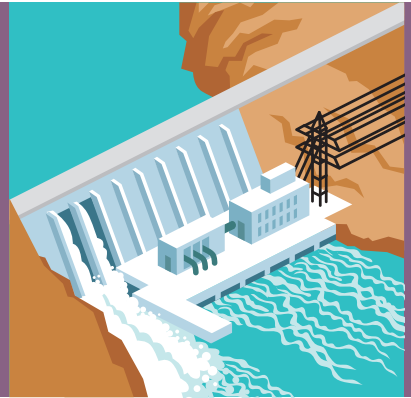


HYDROPOWER WORD SCRAMBLE
