

Emissions Reduction

Cass County Electric Cooperative supports an All-of-the-Above energy policy to provide affordable, reliable, and safe energy to our consumer-members. In 2011, Minnkota Power Cooperative (MPC) completed \$425 million in emission control projects to meet or exceed EPA emissions guidelines at the Milton R. Young Station. That investment addresses sulfur dioxide (SO₂), nitrogen oxides (NO_x), and mercury (Hg) emissions. Project Tundra, a proposed carbon capture venture, is in the advanced engineering and design phase. If constructed, it would remove 90% of CO₂ emissions from either of the Young Station's units, addressing the remaining emissions issues.
